Proposed 43 Percent Increase in 5311 Funding

Part of the President's proposed six-year surface transportation reauthorization for 2012 is almost \$766 million for rural transit funding, a 43% increase over 2010 levels. Although the proposal calls for many structural changes, 5311 funding still would be distributed under similar rules.
