National RTAP has opened up its solicitation for Review Board Nominations for 2010. The term of office for review board members is three years beginning in spring of 2010. National RTAP is soliciting nominations for both state transit officials and representatives from rural or tribal operating systems. Any group or individuals involved in rural transit are encouraged to nominate representatives to the National RTAP board. Furthermore, an individual may nominate him/ herself for consideration.

All 5311 State Program or RTAP Managers and rural operators who receive 5311 or tribal transit funding are eligible for nomination.
