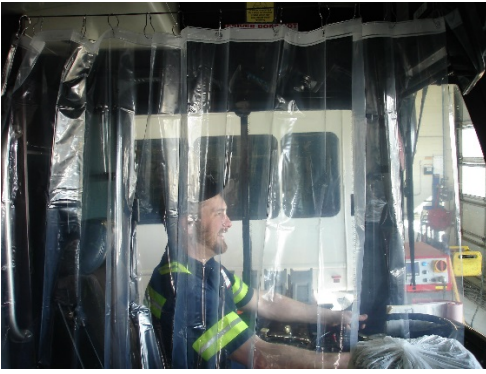
Transaction Corporate Shuttles plexiglass shield

Shields were installed on Transaction Corporate Shuttles by the agency's mechanic.

Battie's Transportation, Inc. plexiglass shield

While their plexiglass shield is on order, their interim barrier is a plastic curtain that goes from ceiling to floor. Drivers are directed to have the curtain closed during the boarding process, and to pull the curtain back so they can clearly see their right-hand mirror once the bus is in motion. Maintenance staff installed the cable at the top first.
